From the total 267 students, (51.1%) of the respondents rated as excellent in respect of achievement of their learning needs by curriculum, followed by 41.9%, 3%, of respondents rated it as good and average respectively but no one replied below average.

The highest (48%) respondents from the total students noted that syllabus of chosen subject found excellent; followed by 46% remarked as good, 6% think it is as average whereas option below average opined in this respect is zero.
