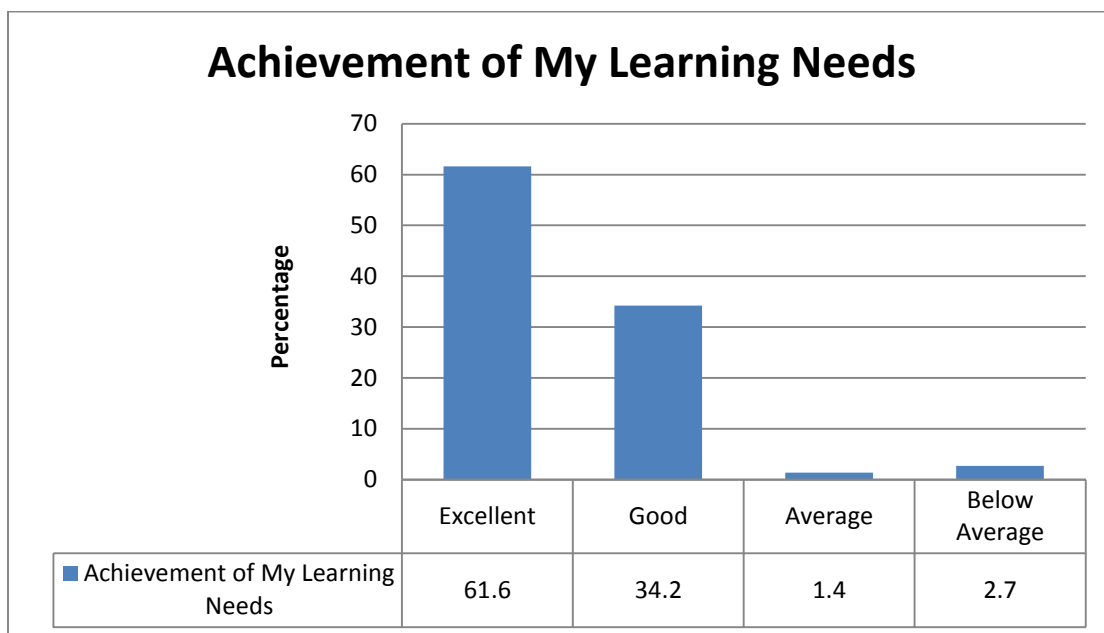
1. Achievement of my learning needs

- **Total 73 alumni are participated in the survey consisting of 12 parameters/aspects which are given above.**



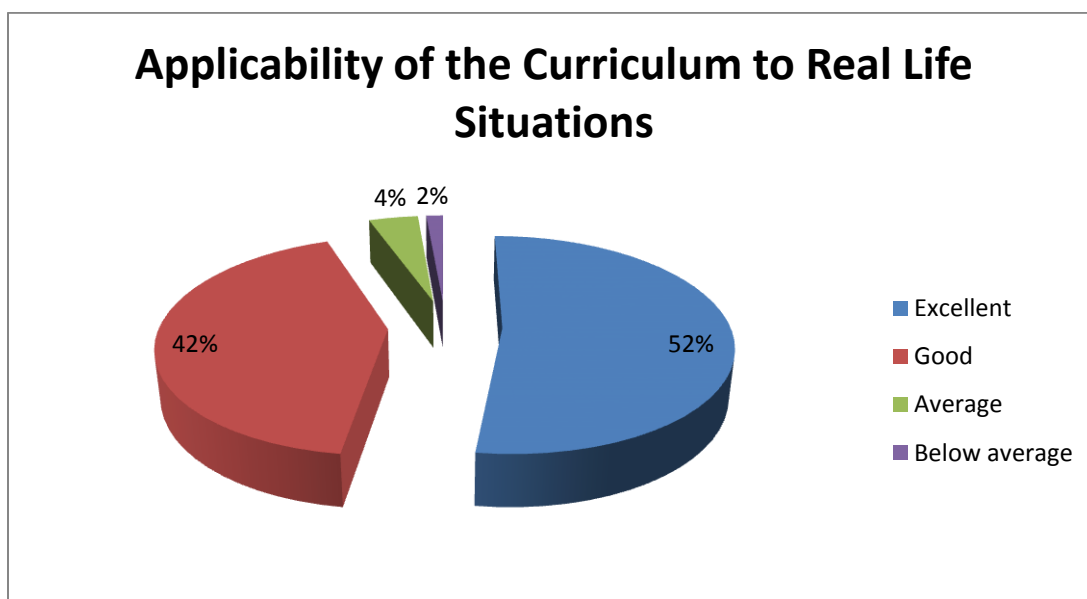
## 1. Fulfillment Of My( Student's) Learning Needs:

## 2. Applicability Of The Curriculum To Real Life Situations:

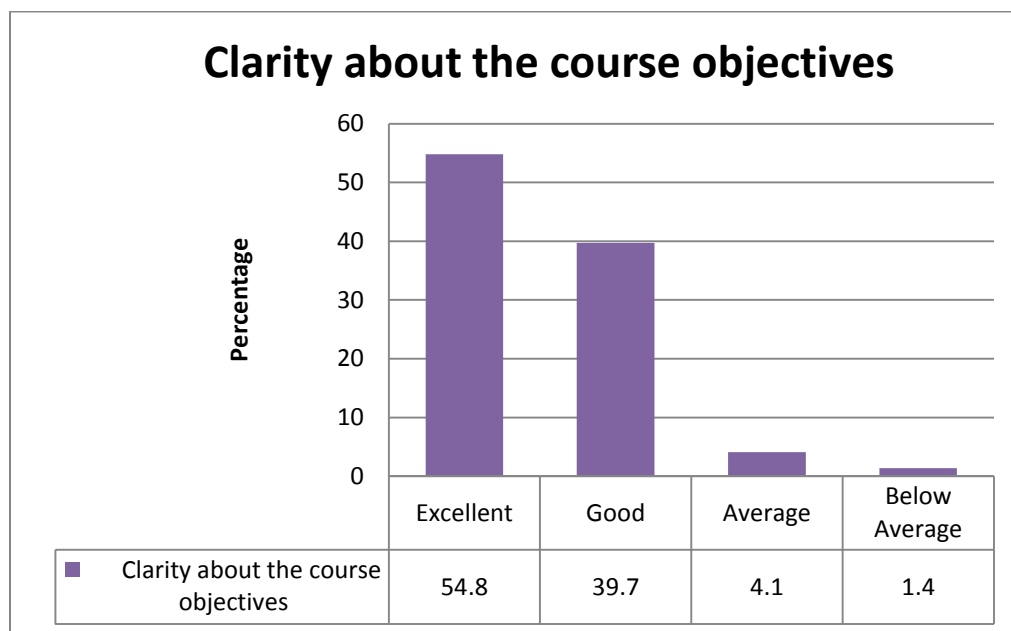
Responses: 73 (52.1%, 42.2%, 4.1%, 1.4%)





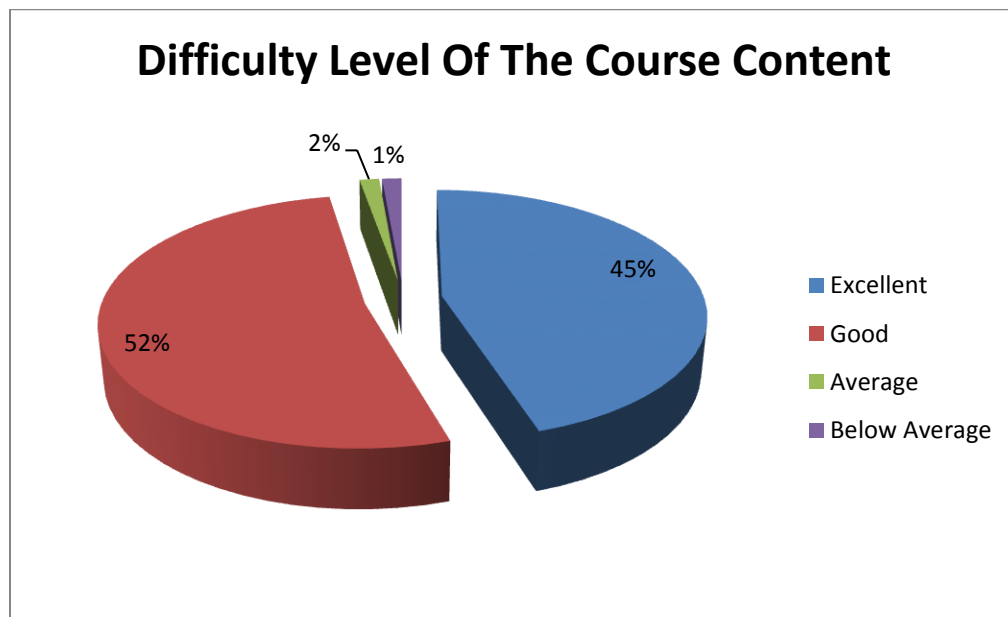
### 3. Clarity About The Course Objectives:

### 4. Difficulty Level Of The Course Content:

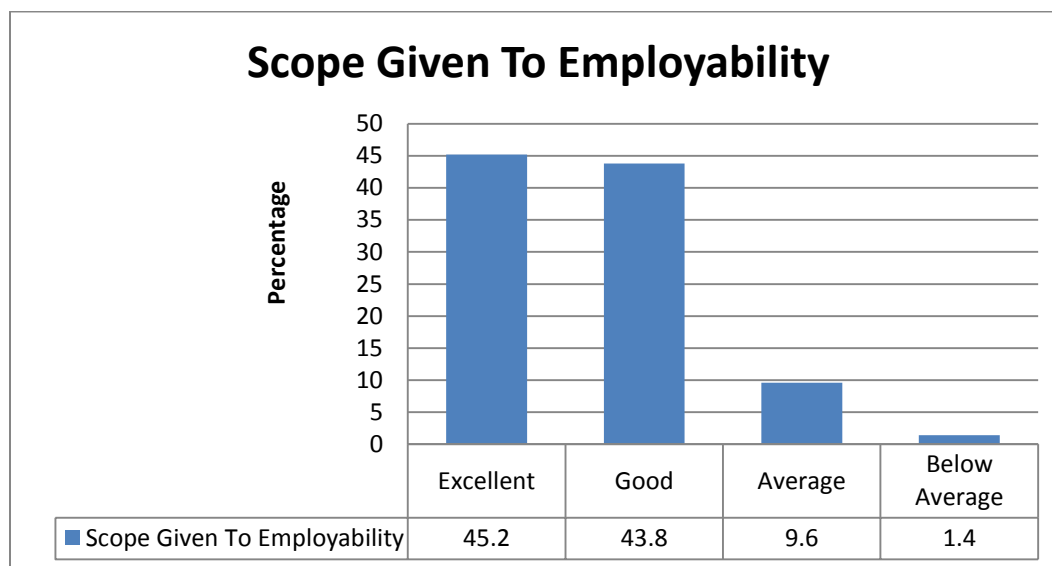

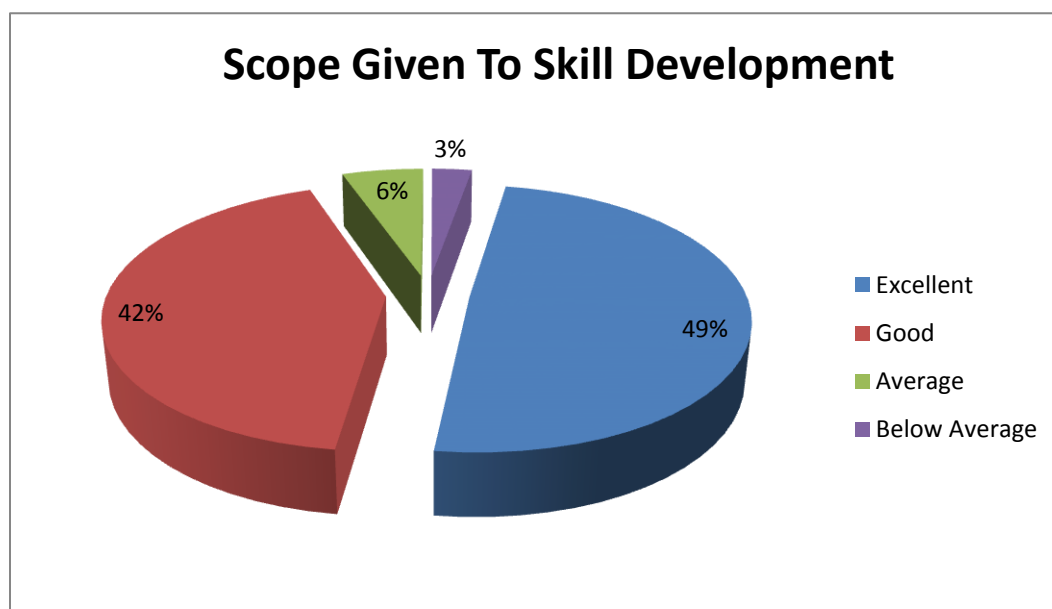
## 5. Scope Given To Employability:

## 6. Scope Given To Skill Development:

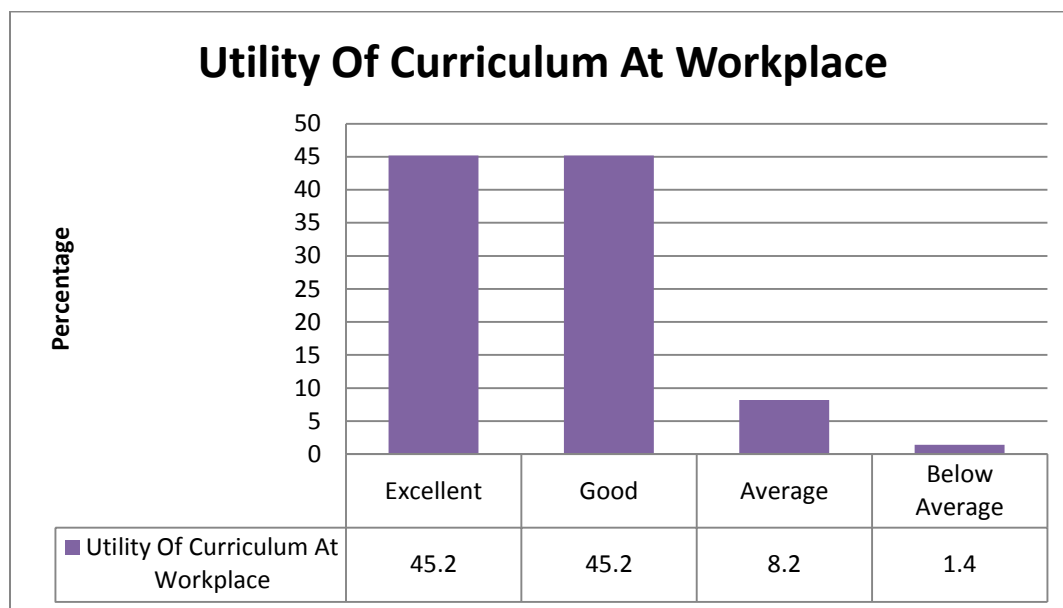
Responses: 73 (49.3%, 42.5%, 5.5%, 2.7%)





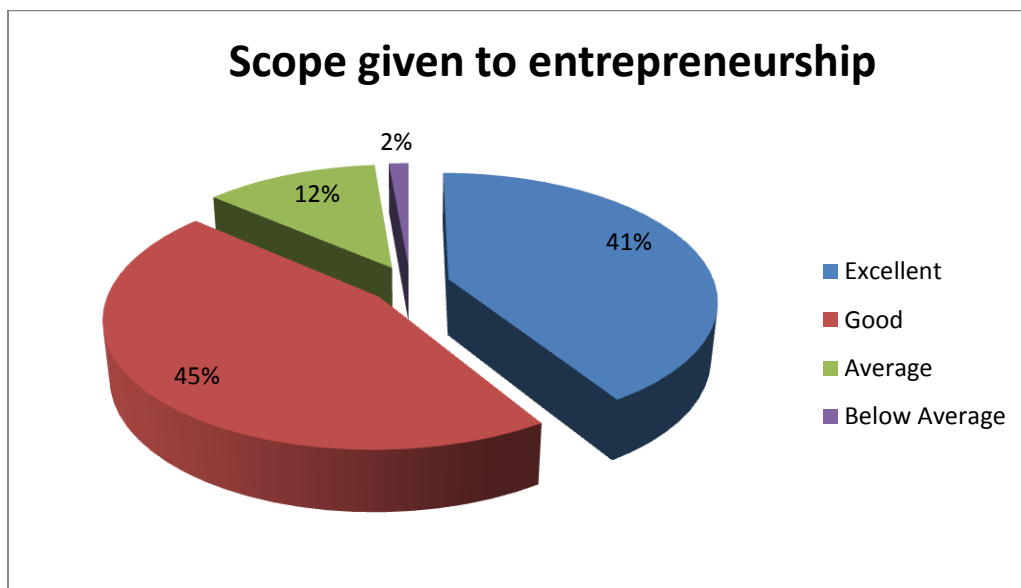
## 7. Utility Of Curriculum At Workplace:

Responses: 73 (45.2%, 45.2%, 8.2%, 1.4%)



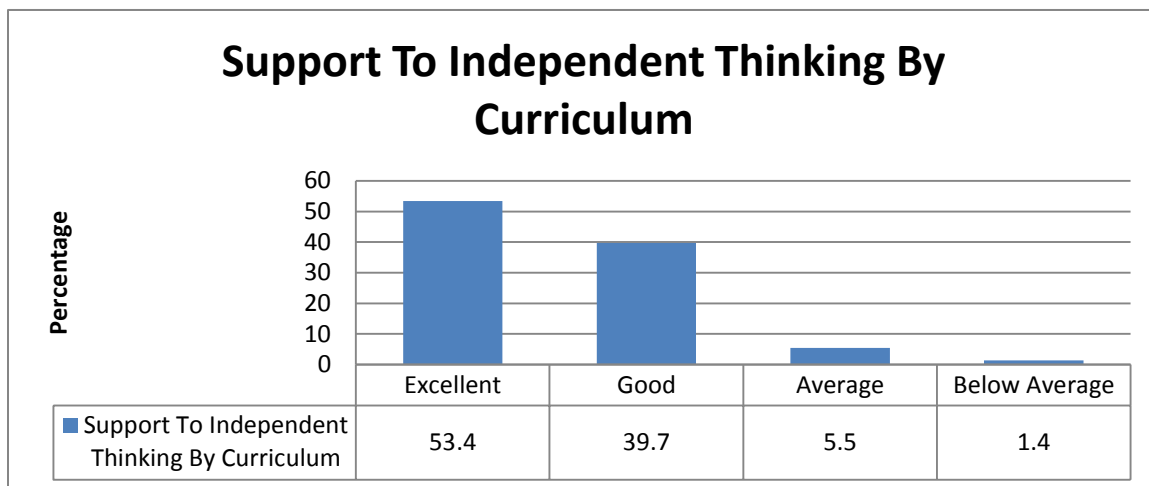
## 8. Scope Given To Entrepreneurship:

Responses: 73 (41.1%, 45.2%, 12.3%, 1.4%)



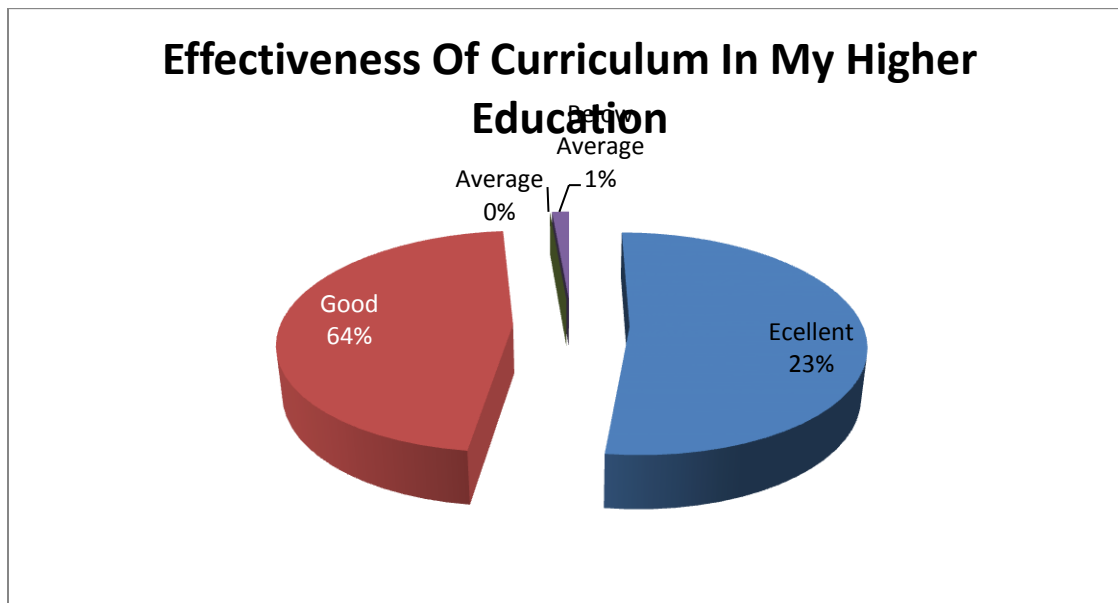
9. **Support To Independent Thinking By Curriculum:**

**Responses: 73** (53.4%, 39.7% 5.5%, 1.4%)



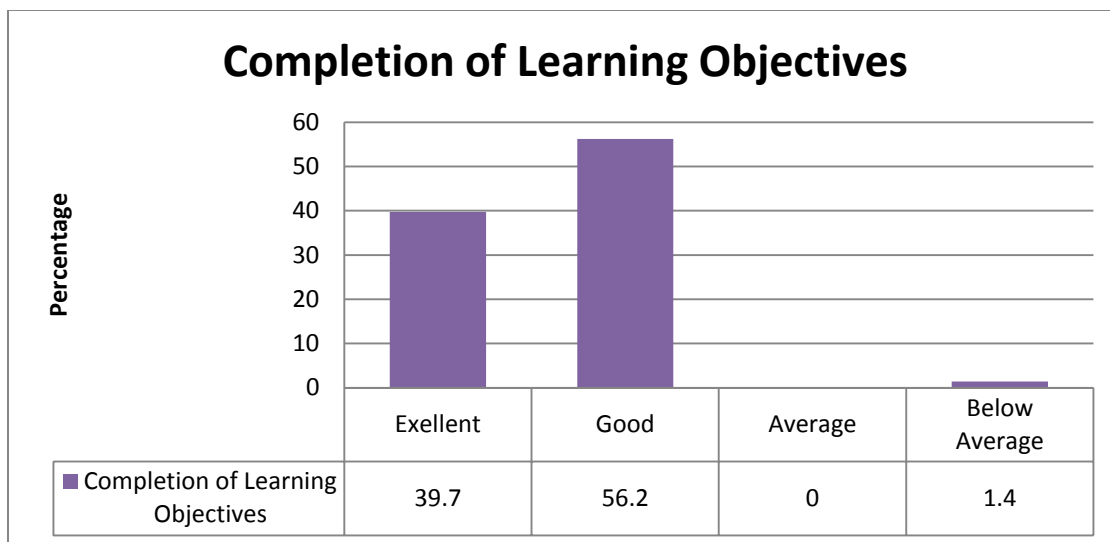
10. **Effectiveness Of Curriculum In My Higher Education:**

**Responses: 73** (52.1%, 46.6%, 0.0%, 1.4%)



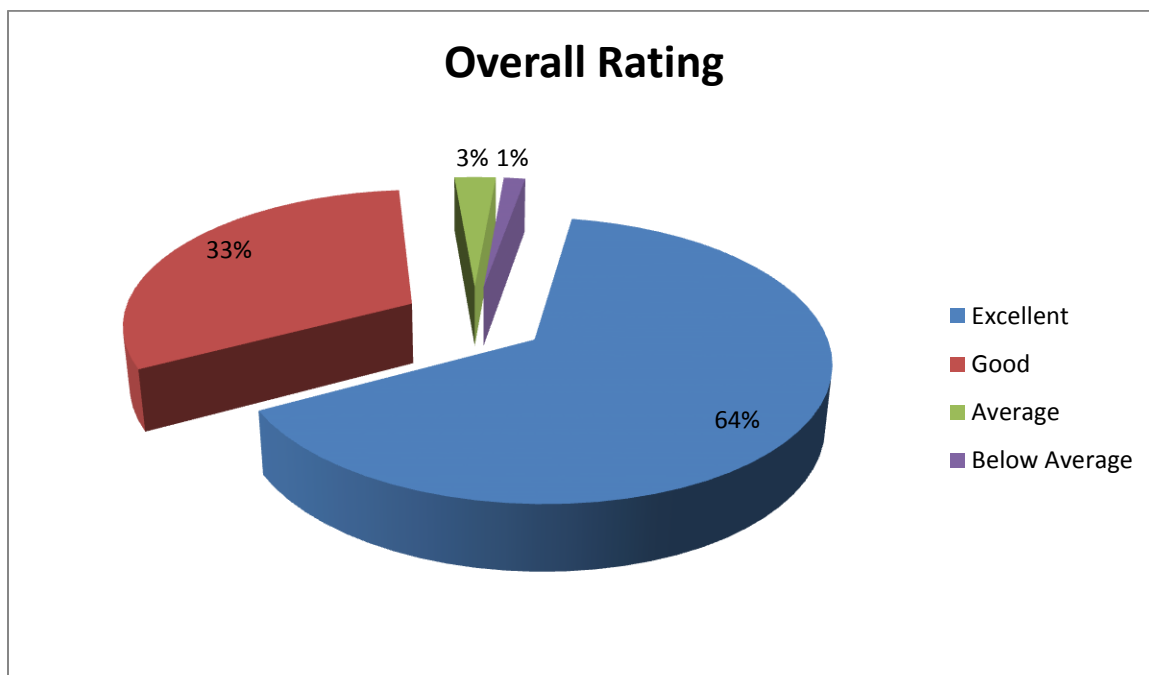
## 11. Completion Of Learning Objectives:

## Alumni Respondents Detail Explanation:

### 1. Fulfillment Of My( alumni) Learning Needs:

In the academic year 2020-21, total 73 alumni (student's) respondents marked their responses on fulfillment of my learning needs aspect and it is found that maximum (61.6%) respondent says excellent in this regard and 34.2% respondents answered as good. Only 1.4% respondents thought good and 2.7% reply to below average option.

### 2. Applicability Of The Curriculum To Real Life Situations:

It is found that the majority (52.1%) number of alumni student's respondent opined that the applicability of the curriculum to the real life situation found excellent, 42.5% think curriculum is good; followed by 4.1% remarked as average and 1.4% says below average.

### 3. Clarity About The Course Objectives:

From the total 73 alumni respondent's majority (54.8%) respondent opined that clarity about the course objectives in curriculum found excellent; followed by 39.7% reflect it is as good, 4.1% declares average, 1.4% respondents observed as below average.

### 4. Difficulty Level Of The Course Content:

In this survey the fourth aspect concerned with difficulty level of the course content. It is observed that 45.2%) respondents from the total alumni's noted that this aspect found excellent; followed by 52.1% mentioned as good, 1.4% responses replied for average and below average option's each in this aspect.

### 5. Scope Given To Employability:

It is witnessed that the maximum (45.2%) of alumni respondent opined that scope given to employability in curriculum found excellent; 43.8% says it is good, 9.6% rated it as average and 1.4% responses remarked as below average option.

### 6. Scope Given To Skill Development:

The majority of (49.3%) alumni respondent observed that scope given to skill development in curriculum is mentioned excellent; followed by 42.5% remarked as good;



5.5% says average and below average are selected by only 2.7% respondents regarding to this aspect.

**7. Utility Of Curriculum At Workplace:**

The seventh aspect of the feedback is related with utility of curriculum at workplace. The assembled information stipulate that the 45.2% respondents found utility of curriculum at workplace is excellent, followed by 45.2% says it is good, 8.2% opined as it is average whereas 1.4% think about the as below average option in this parameter.

**8. Scope Given To Entrepreneurship:**

The maximum (41.1%) respondents from the total alumni's notated that, scope given to entrepreneurship from curriculum is found excellent; followed by 45.2% replied as good, 12.3% says it is as average and below average option is replied by 1.4% respondents to this aspect.

**9. Support to independent thinking by curriculum:**

It is observed that the bulk (53.4%) of respondents reflect that support to independent thinking by curriculum observed excellent; followed by 39.7% of opined it is good, 5.5% says it is as average and 1.4% says as below average in this regard.

**10. Effectiveness Of Curriculum In My Higher Education:**

The majority (52.1%) respondents from the total alumni's noted that effectiveness of curriculum in my higher education is found excellent; followed by 46.6% reproduced as good, no one respondent says average but 1.4% think it is as below average option in this aspect.

**11. Completion Of Learning Objectives:**

The eleventh option of this feedback is concerned with completion of learning objectives. It is found that the extreme (39.7%) of alumni's respondent answered found excellent; 56.2% shows it is good, 2.7 % rated it as average and only 1.4% selected as below average option in this aspect.

**12. Overall Rating:**

Essential and last parameter of feedback is regarding overall rating of curriculum. From the entire collected information the extreme figure of respondents (64.4%) witnessed that

curriculum is excellent, followed by 31.5% stated it is good, 2.7% says as it is average and 1.4% alumni replied as below average option.

The combined feedback report of alumni's on curriculum is shared with the all HOD's /Coordinators/ Officials of various department for further suitable action and decision making in this respect.
