Online feedback on curriculum collected from the employers of various fields through online for the academic year 2020-21. This survey comprises 12 aspects which include:

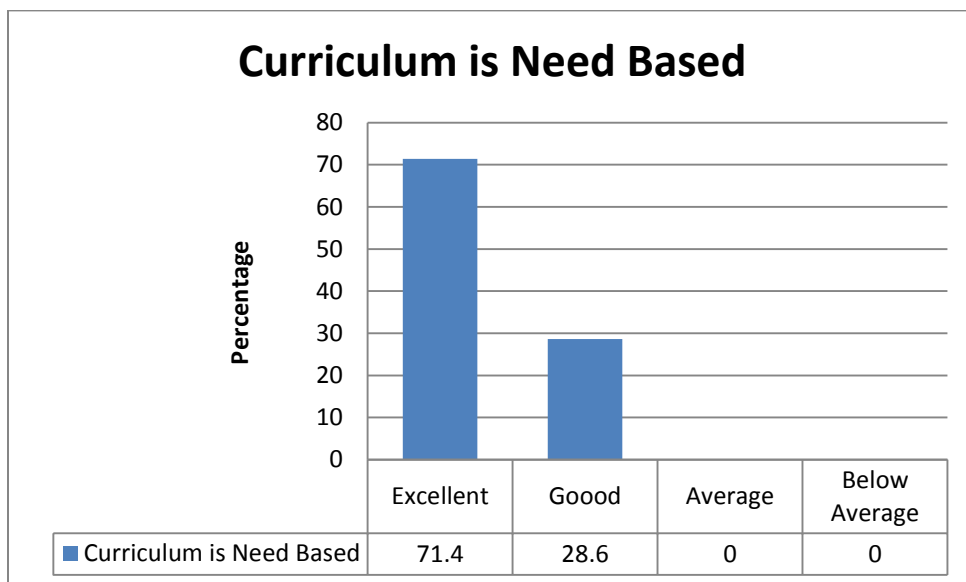
1. Curriculum is need based

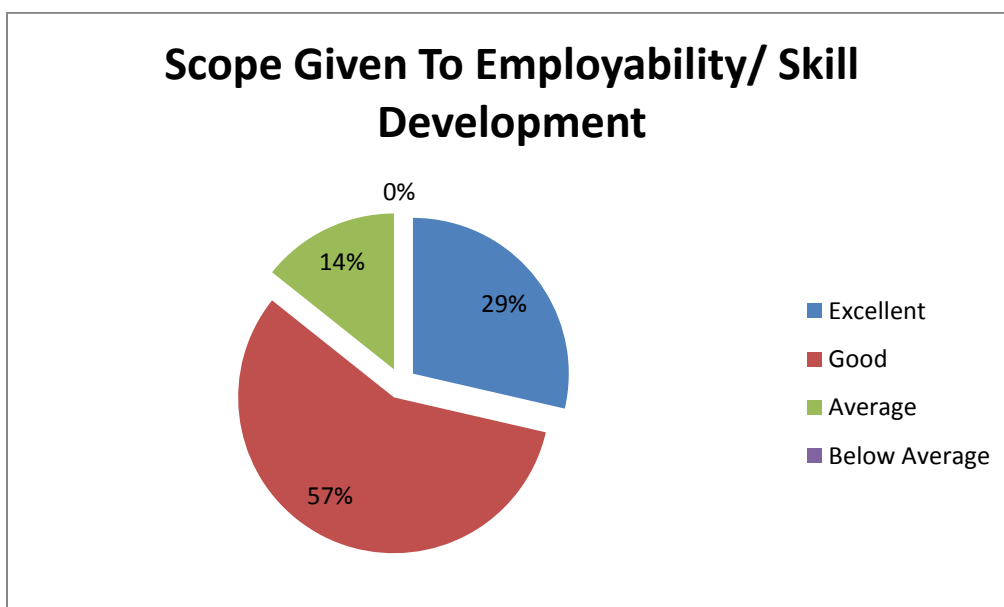
1. Curriculum Is Need Based:

2. Scope Given To Employability/Skill Development:

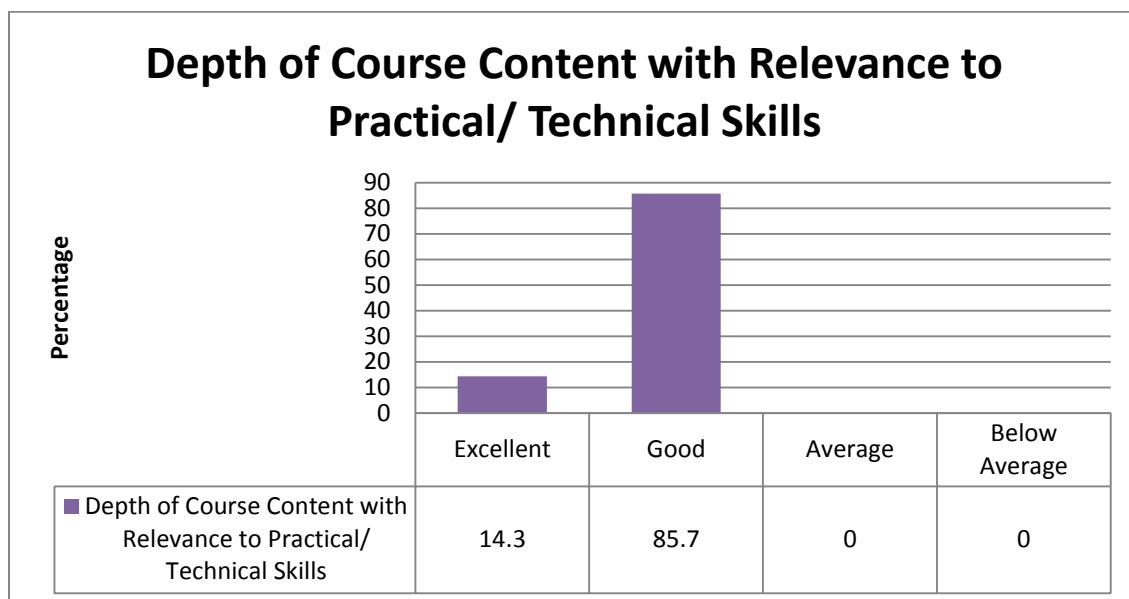

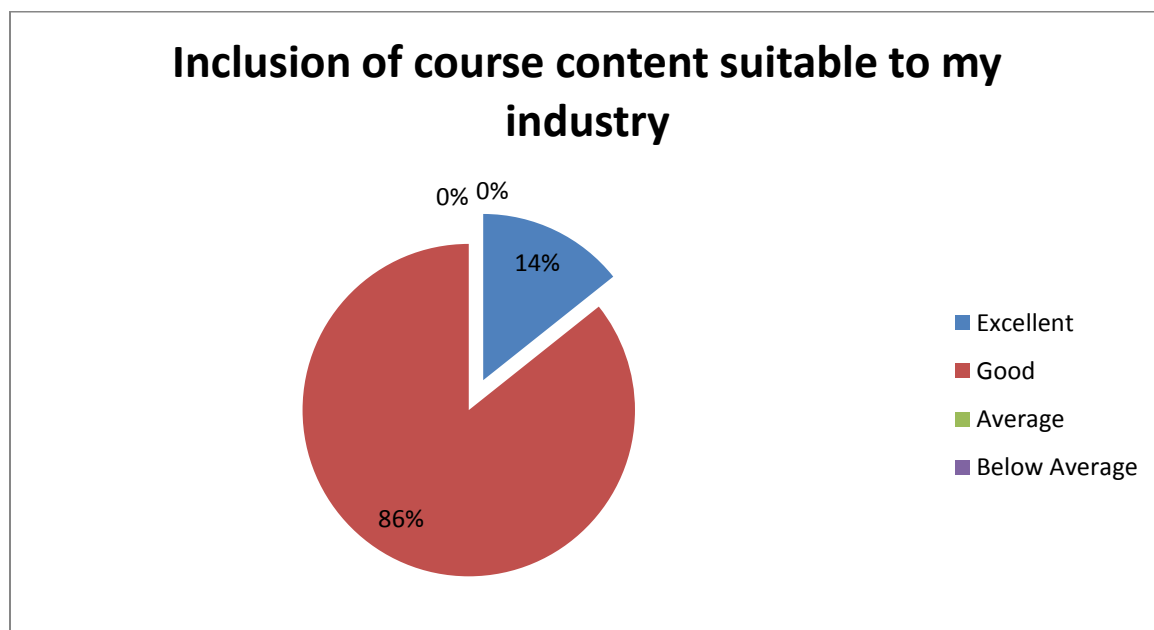
3. Depth of course content with relevance to practical/ technical skills

4. Inclusion of course content suitable to my industry:

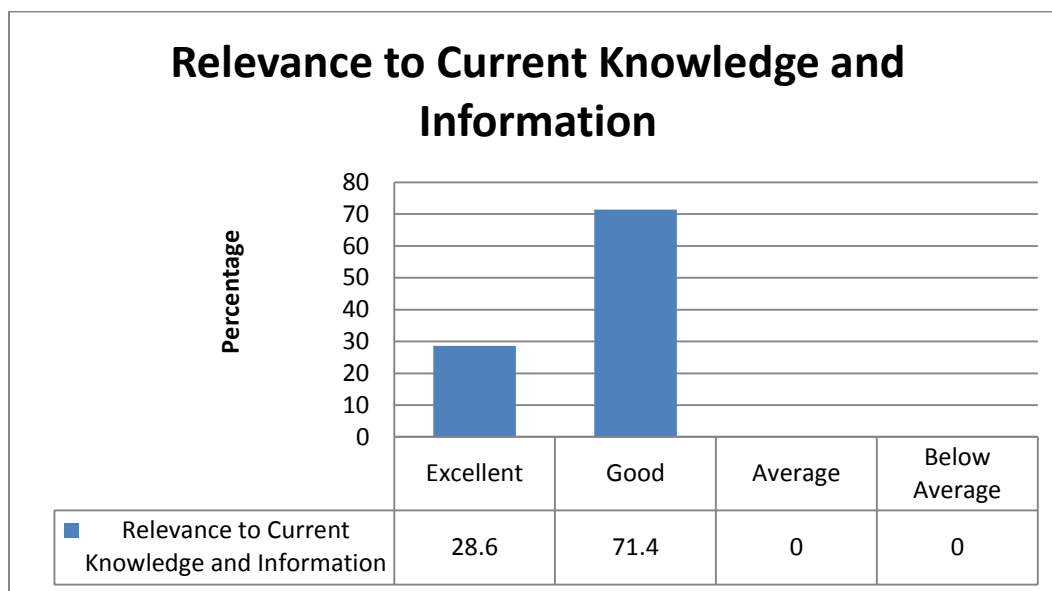

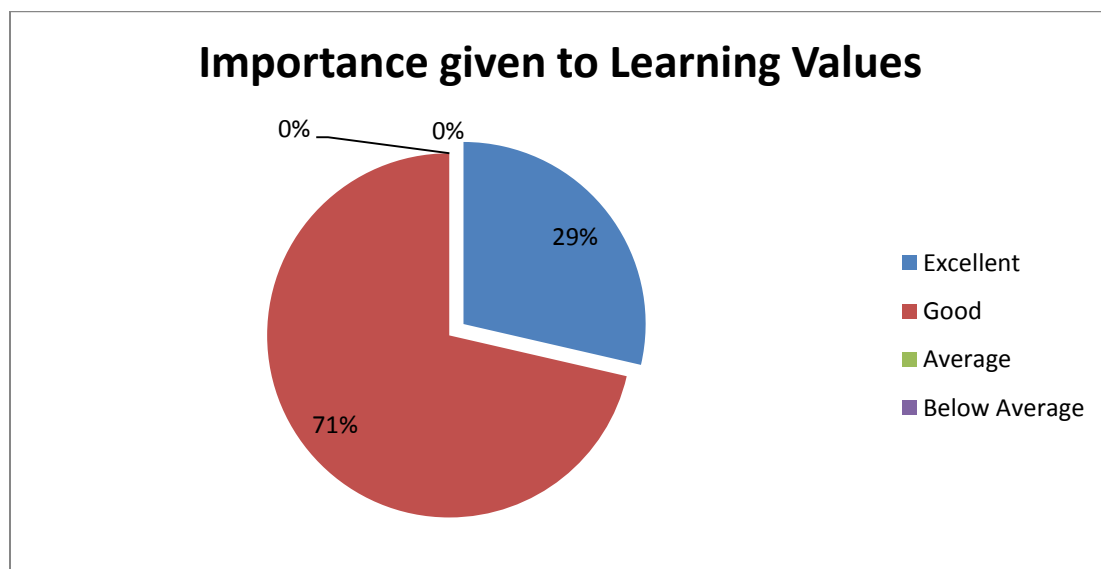
5. Relevance to current knowledge and information:

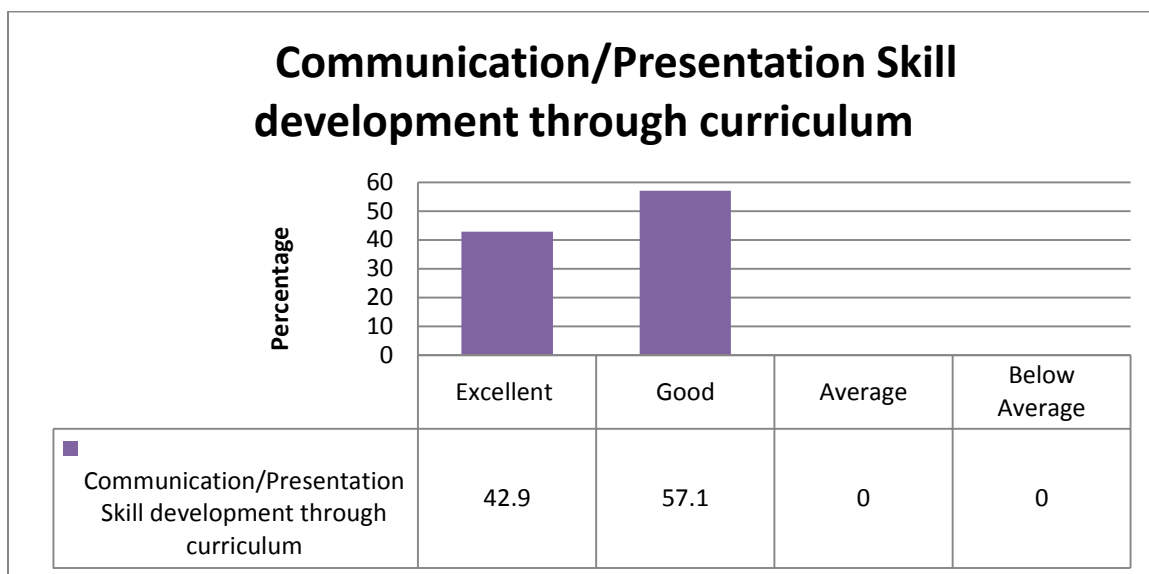

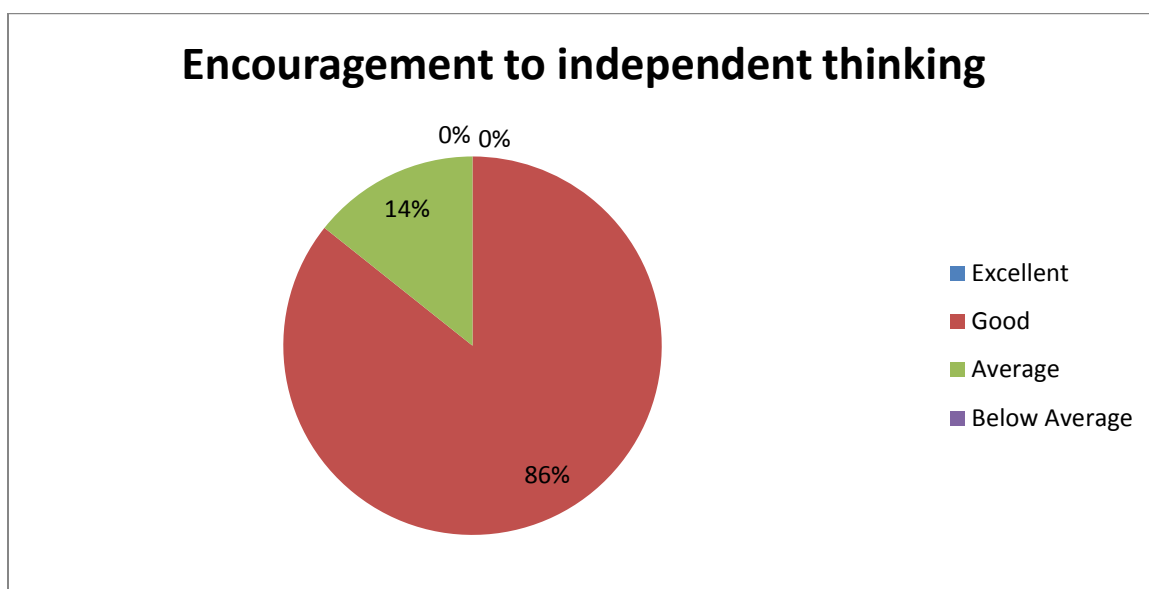
7. Communication/Presentation Skill development through curriculum

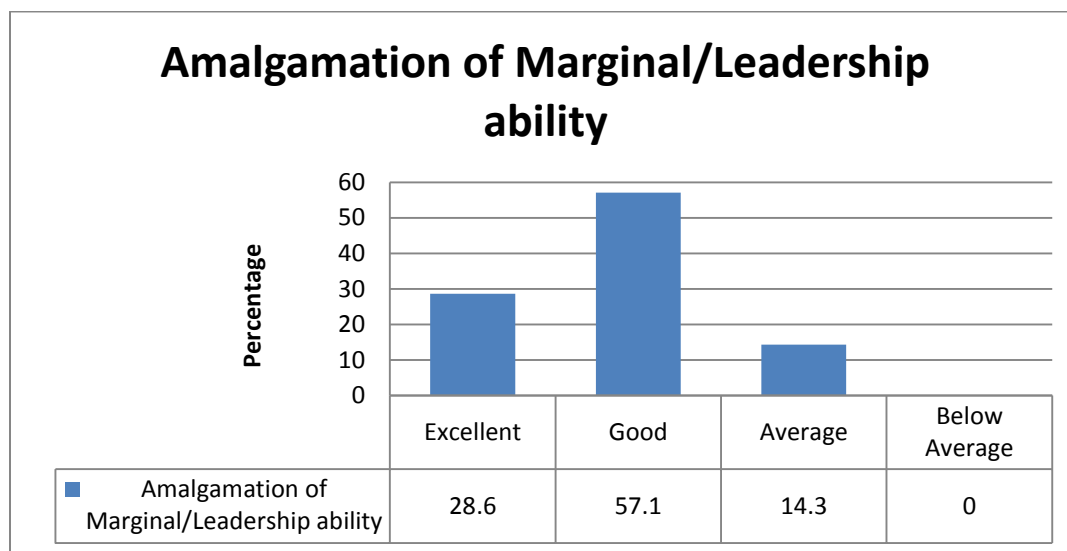

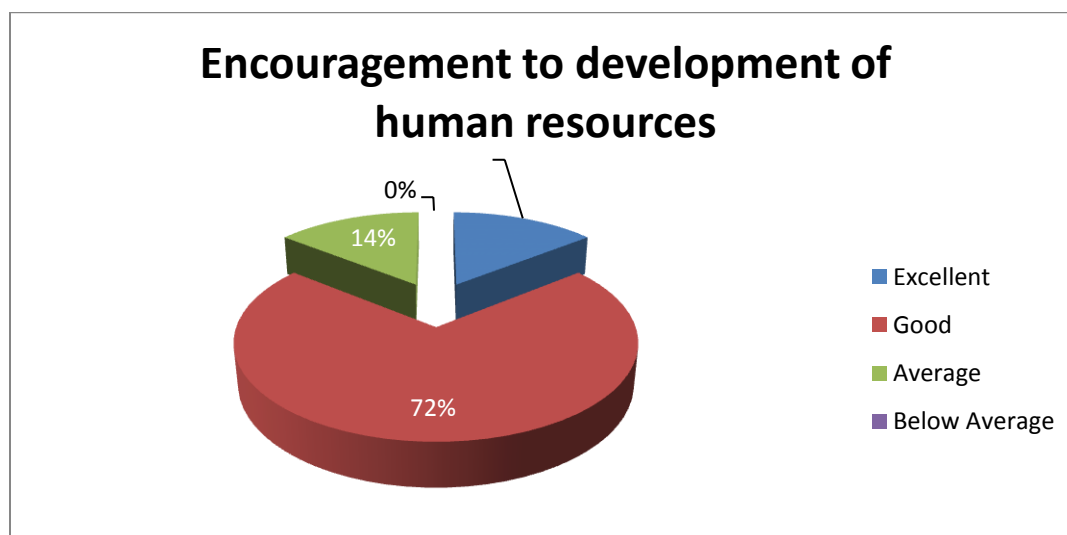
9. Amalgamation of Marginal/Leadership ability:

10. Encouragement to development of human resources:

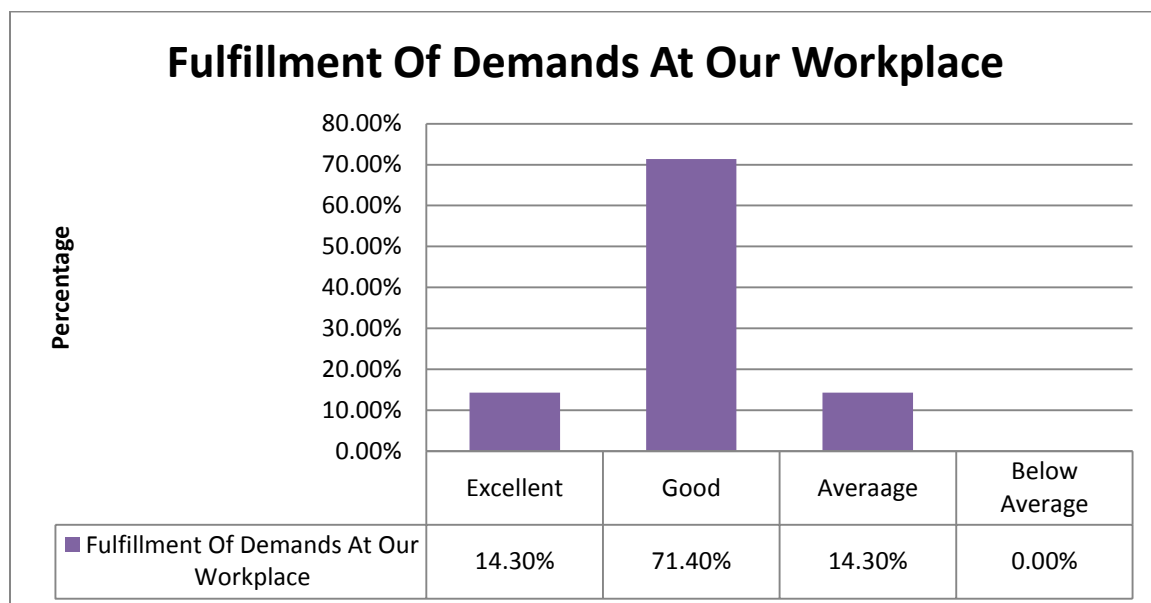

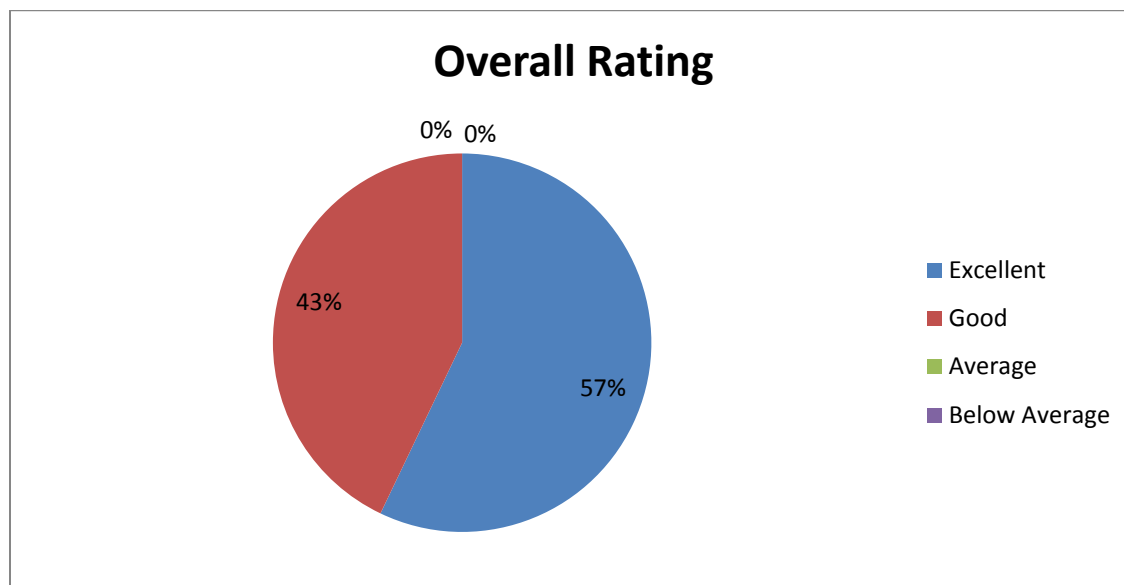
11. Fulfillment Of Demands At Our Workplace:

Employer Respondents Detail Explanation:

1. Curriculum Is Need Based:

In the academic year 2020-21, total 07 employer respondents marked their responses on curriculum is need based aspect. It is found that maximum (71.4%) respondent says excellent in this regard and 28.6% respondents replied as good. Respondents neither selected as good and as below average option in this aspect.

2. Scope Given To Employability/Skill Development:

The 28.6% respondent employer opined that scope given to employability/skill development in curriculum is found excellent; followed by 57.1% remarked as good, 14.3% opined it is as average, no one select the below average option in this regard.

3. Depth of course content with relevance to practical/ technical skills

From the total 07 employer respondent's; 14.3% says that the depth of course content with relevance to practical/ technical skills in curriculum found excellent; followed by 85.7% think it is as good. Responses not received for remaining both the options as average and as below average in this case.

4. Inclusion of course content suitable to my industry:

The fourth aspect of this survey concerned with inclusion of course content suitable to my industry and 42.9% respondents from the total employer noted that this aspect found excellent; followed by 42.72% remarked as good, none think about as average and below average option in this aspect.

5. Relevance to current knowledge and information:

It is observed that the 28.6% of employer's respondent opined that relevance to current knowledge and information in curriculum found excellent; majority (71.4%) says it is good, but nobody rated it as average and as below average option to this parameter.

6. Importance given to learning values:

The 28.6% respondent employer opined that importance given to learning values in curriculum is observed excellent; followed by 71.4% remarked as good. The last two options average and below average are not selected by any employers regarding to this aspect.

7. Communication/Presentation Skill development through curriculum

The seventh aspect of the feedback is concerned with communication/presentation skill development through curriculum. The assembled information specify that the employer respondents (42.9%) found communication/presentation skill development through curriculum is excellent, followed by 57.1% says it is good,. No one opined as it is average and about as below average option in this parameter.

8. Encouragement to independent thinking:

The respondents does not think excellent option regarding to encouragement to independent thinking from curriculum; majority of (85.7%) replied as good, 14.3% says it is as average but below average option is not replied by any one respondents to this aspect.

9. Amalgamation of Marginal/Leadership ability:

It is observed that 28.6%) of employer's consider that curriculum has amalgamation of marginal/leadership ability observed excellent; followed by 57.1% of opined it is good, 14.3% says it is as average and no one remarked as below average in this regard.

10. Encouragement to development of human resources:

The 14.3% respondents from the total employer noted that encouragement to development of human resources from curriculum is found excellent; followed by 57.1% reflected as good, 28.6% reproduced it is as average whereas nobody select as below average option in this aspect.

11. Fulfillment Of Demands At Our Workplace:

The last but one option of this feedback is fulfillment of demands at our workplace. It is found that (14.3%) of employer's respondent replied that the fulfillment of demands at our workplace by curriculum is found excellent; 71.4% shows it is good, 14.3 % rated it as average and no one selected as below average option in this aspect.

12. Overall Rating:

Decisive and last parameter of feedback is regarding overall rating of curriculum. From the entire collected information the maximum number of respondents (57.1%) observed that curriculum is excellent, followed by 42.9% declare it is good, but not think about average and below average options by any employer replied as below average option.
