Students have to complete this course while learning in second year. Student has to submit the project work in time. There will be annual examination of this course at the end of the year (Probably in February) which will be conducted by University. Students have to pay Rs.100/- towards fees prescribed by Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University and Rs.50/- as a examination fees for this course.
- 3) Result of students who do not complete above two course will not be declared by the University.

Rules for Admission:-

- ☐ Student has to complete the admission within ten days after declaration of result of qualifying examination.
- ☐ Student should remain present personally at the time of admission.
- ☐ He/She has to fill up the admission form carefully after reading an important instructions in this prospectus and admission form.

Library

College has good collection of text books, e-books & e-journals. Facility of internet is available in library for students and staff members.

Rules of the Library :-

- i) Two books at a time will be issued to the students.
- ii) Identity card is compulsory to avail the Library facility. Books will not be issued to the students without Identity cards.
- iii) Student can retain books for one week. A fine of Rs.1/- per day per book will be charged for delay in returning the books.
- iv) Any attempt to damage books will be treated as misconduct and a student has to pay 1.5 times the price of the books.
- v) If the books is lost by student, He/She has to communicate it immediately to the Librarian and has to pay 1.5 times the price of that book.
- vi) All the books issued to the student should be returned before commencement of annual examination.
- vii) If the student has to retain books for the period of examination, he/she has to pay the amount 1.5 times to the price of that book as a deposit.
- viii) All students must obtain "No dues" certificate from the library before taking transfer certificate from the college.

Identity Card

Student should always carry Identity card with self attested latest photograph. This photograph on I-card should be attested by Principal/Vice Principal of the college. Student should produce I-card when it will be asked by any of the staff member of the college.

Identity card is necessary for a student at every moment like library transaction, for scholarship, fees concession, sports, cultural or extracurricular activities & competitions, bus concession, examination, annual gathering or even for entry in the college campus.

Attendance

- i) It is compulsory for student to keep minimum attendance of 75% Students must be regular for theory lectures, practical classes & all the academic activities.
- ii) A student who does not fulfill a minimum of 75% attendance during the academic year will not be allowed to appear for the annual examination.
- iii) Absence, without prior permission for any single class lecture shall be regarded as absence for the whole day.

Discipline

- i) Self discipline is the best discipline.
- ii) All students are expected to obey the rules & regulations currently in force to enable the smooth working of the college.
- iii) Students are prohibited from doing anything inside or outside the college that will interfere with its orderly administration or affect its public image.

Facilities available

◆ **Laboratories:-**

College has well equipped laboratories for various Science & Commerce subject & for Psychology, Geography, Home Science and Dramatics in the Arts stream.

◆ **Self Financing courses:-**

College has designed its own syllabus which is useful for all Competitive Examinations i.e. UPSC, MPSC, STI, PSI, Staff selection Commission, Bank Recruitment Examinations etc. There is a provision of two regular lectures on every Friday and Saturday to complete this syllabus by deputing a learned and experienced faculty. Some additional guest lectures by a reputed visiting faculties are also frequently arranged.

There is separate admission procedure for this cell. Admission are given to interested student on first come first serve basis after testing their general aptitude test. Interested student will have to register their names as per the procedure of the cell.

◆ **Student Council:-**

Student's Council is constituted as per the Maharashtra University Act,2016.

This council has active role and participation in the organization of various programs in the college.

◆ **NSS (National Service Scheme):-**

The NSS unit of the college has been recognized as one of the best units in University. University has allotted two units with intake capacity of 250 students. Certificates are given to only those students who have completed 120 hours of work & have participated in a special camp organized by NSS unit. Students have to register their names for the membership of the unit.

◆ **Life Long Learning & Extension Department (LLED):-**

This unit works according to the guidelines of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad.

◆ **U.G.C. Network Resource Center (N.R.C.):-**
